



Waldwick Concludes Its 2016-2017 Indoor Concert Series

The Waldwick Band concludes its 2016-2017 Winter Season with a concert on Sunday afternoon, April 30th at The Village School in Waldwick. The concert will begin at 2:30 p.m., and will include the Waldwick High School Concert Band as guest artists. The Village School is located at 100 West Prospect Street in Waldwick, close to the Waldwick High School athletic field, and offers a fine auditorium with theater style seating for concert attendees. There is no admission charge for the concert.

The Waldwick High School Concert Band under the direction of their conductor Lynne Montella will present three compositions to open the second half of the program. The High School Band will perform **Carnegie Anthem**, by American composer William Owens, music from **Lawrence of Arabia** by Maurice Jarre as arranged by Alfred Reed, and **The All American Concert March** by Chris Sharp. The high school band will join with the Waldwick Band at the end of the performance to play Pascual Marquina famous paso doble **Espana Cani** and Sousa's **Washington Post March**.

The Waldwick Band will be under the baton of its maestro Edmund A. Moderacki. Among the compositions that the conductor has selected are **Overture to L'Inganno Felice** by Rossini, **Fugue and Chorale on Yankee Doodle** by Virgil Thompson, and Gliere's **Russian Sailors' Dance**. Also on the program will be **Gershwin**, an arrangement of the composer's music by Robert Russell Bennett, Selections from the Broadway Musical **Damn Yankees** and marches by Alford, Alexander and Fillmore.
