

The Waldwick Band Continues Its Free Concerts

The Waldwick Band continues its 2016-2017 Winter Season with a concert on Sunday afternoon, March 12th at The Village School in Waldwick. The concert, featuring saxophonist Lew Archer, will begin at 2:30 p.m. The Village School is located at 100 West Prospect Street in Waldwick, close to the Waldwick High School athletic field, and offers a fine auditorium with theater style seating for concert attendees. There is no admission charge for the concert.

Lewis Archer will be the featured instrumentalist. The principal saxophonist with the Waldwick Band, Mr. Archer studied with the noted saxophone teacher Paul Cohen and has performed with the Ridgewood Concert Band, the Rutherford Band and the Teaneck Summer Band. The soloist has appeared as a featured player on numerous earlier occasions with the band soloing on the soprano, alto, tenor and baritone saxophones. For this concert he will perform **The Theme from Schindler's List** by John Williams.

The band will be under the baton of music director Edmund A. Moderacki who will open the concert with its 2016-2017 signature piece, **Seventy-six Trombones** by Meredith Wilson as arranged by Leroy Anderson. Moderacki will conduct the ensemble in Carl Maria von Weber's **Invitation to the Dance** and The Overture to **Die Fledermaus** by Johann Strauss Jr. Also on the program will be selections from **Perthshire Majesty** by Samuel R. Hazo, **The Universal Judgement** by de Nardis, **Minor Alterations** by David Lovrein and selections from the long running off Broadway show **The Fantastics**.
